

### **ABOUT THIS REPORT**

This report, per Arizona Board of Regents policy 2-122, provides enrollment data for students attending Arizona's public universities in the 2019-20 academic year and updates multi-year enrollment trends. Twenty-first day headcount and 45th-day full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment data is provided for each university and their campuses.

Within higher education, enrollment is generally expressed in student headcount or FTE terms. Student headcount is reported for the purposes of determining educational scale and measurement against metric goals. Headcount is defined as the number of full- or part-time individual students registered at a university for at least one credit hour on the 21st day of instruction. Student headcount is considered a broad measure of a university's educational reach, reflecting the number of individuals the university is educating at one time.

Student FTE has historically been used for calculating state funding and to determine how university revenues are budgeted among colleges, schools, departments and programs. FTE is generally defined as a measurement of credit hours equal to one full-time student enrolled for one academic year. Arizona's student FTE enrollment is computed according to A.R.S. §15-1661 and board policy and guidelines.

The enrollment analysis within this report uses student headcount numbers unless specifically identified as using an FTE calculation. Student enrollment is counted across all education delivery modalities, including online and extended campuses. The report further disaggregates the data into undergraduate, graduate and total enrollment. Data is presented by demographics, full-time and part-time student enrollment semester credit hours, and residency status.

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### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Enrollment at Arizona's public universities continues to increase with notable growth in the number of students taking online programs.

During the fall of fiscal year 2020, total student enrollment at Arizona's public universities is 195,672, a 4.7 percent increase over the prior year. Reflecting the growing popularity of online courses that offer flexibility and convenience for students, most of the growth is attributed to online degree program enrollment. Since fiscal year 2016, online degree program enrollment has more than doubled, increasing by 112 percent. Online degree program students now comprise 27.3 percent of total enrollment.

System enrollment overall met or exceeded undergraduate, graduate and total enrollment goals in the board's strategic plan that is designed to advance education and research while positively impacting Arizona. Increasing educational attainment for more Arizonans is a key focus for the board and universities as the state transitions to an economy where the majority of jobs demand education past high school. The Fiscal Year 2020 Fall Enrollment Report represents one mechanism to track annual progress toward these goals.

### **Arizona Public University Enterprise Enrollment Trends**

- Undergraduate students totaled 158,135 at Arizona's public universities this fall semester.
  This 4.4 percent year-over-year increase exceeded the 2020 metric goal by 1.1 percent.
  Since 2016, undergraduate enrollment grew 18.9 percent from 132,986 to 158,135 and
  increased 25 percent in graduate enrollment from 30,029 to 37,537. Among graduate and
  professional students, 37,537 were enrolled in the universities, exceeding the strategic
  metric goal by 3.7 percent.
- This fall, the majority of students enrolled in Arizona's public universities were residents of the state. These 104,494 resident students were joined by 91,178 non-resident students for a total enrollment of 195.672.
- Among online degree program students, 53,369 students enrolled in an online degree program this fall semester, 25.7 percent of whom are Arizona residents. In addition, 114,251 students took at least one online class at an Arizona public university. More than half 58.4 percent of enrolled students now take at least one online course.

### UNIVERSITY ENROLLMENT TRENDS

### **Arizona State University**

- Headcount enrollment at Arizona State University increased across all campuses with a notable, year-over-year total increase of 7.8 percent. ASU's total enrollment for this fall is 119,951, exceeding last year's total enrollment by 8,702 students and surpassing the 2020 metric goal by 10 percent. ASU's total enrollment has grown 32 percent since fiscal year 2016.
- This fall semester, ASU had 96,726 undergraduate students enrolled, surpassing last year's undergraduate enrollment by 6,838 and exceeding the 2020 metric goal by 10.4

- percent. ASU's graduate enrollment for this fall semester is 23,225, surpassing last year's graduate enrollment by 1,864 and exceeding the 2020 metric goal by 8.6 percent.
- ASU's online degree program enrollment for this fall semester is 43,342, comprising 36.1
  percent of total enrollment. ASU had 33,253 undergraduate students and 10,089 graduate
  students enrolled in online degree programs.
- ASU's FTE enrollment is 110,891, 92 percent of headcount enrollment.

### **Northern Arizona University**

- Growth at the main and satellite campuses of NAU declined slightly this year. NAU's total
  enrollment for this fall semester is 30,733, a decrease from last year's total enrollment by 333
  students and missing the 2020 metric goal by 4.5 percent. NAU's total enrollment has grown
  by 5.9 percent since fiscal year 2016.
- This fall semester, NAU has 26,511 undergraduate students enrolled, a decrease from last year's undergraduate enrollment of 561 students and missing the 2020 metric goal by 5.1 percent.
- NAU's graduate enrollment for this fall semester is 4,222, exceeding last year's graduate enrollment by 228 students, but missing the 2020 metric goal by 0.4 percent.
- NAU's online degree program enrollment for this fall semester is 5,550, comprising 18.1 percent of total enrollment. NAU had 4,040 undergraduate students enrolled in an online degree program and 1,410 graduate students enrolled in an online degree program.
- NAU's FTE enrollment is 29,011, 94 percent of headcount enrollment.

#### **University of Arizona**

- Enrollment at the University of Arizona increased slightly at the main campus. The university's total enrollment for this fall semester is 44,988, an increase from last year's total enrollment by 462 students, which missed the 2020 metric goal by 12.6 percent. Total enrollment has grown by 4.4 percent since fiscal year 2016.
- This fall semester, UArizona had 34,898 undergraduate students enrolled, an increase of 351 from last year's undergraduate enrollment of 34,547 students, which missed the 2020 metric goal by 14.6 percent.
- Graduate enrollment for this fall semester is 10,090, up from last year's graduate enrollment by 111 students and missing the 2020 metric goal by 4.5 percent.
- Online degree program enrollment for this fall semester is 4,477, comprising 9.9 percent of total enrollment. UArizona had 2,109 undergraduate students and 2,368 graduate students enrolled in an online degree program.
- FTE enrollment is 44,659, 99 percent of headcount enrollment.

### **Educational Attainment and Future Enrollment Trends**

As the largest producers of undergraduate and graduate degrees in Arizona, the board's strategic goals support a statewide initiative to increase educational attainment to at least 60 percent of adults with a college degree or professional certification by 2030.


At the undergraduate level, increasing enrollment may become progressively more difficult in the future with projected drops in overall K-12 enrollment as a result of declining Arizona birth rates during the Great Recession. Total K-12 enrollment is projected to be flat for the next few years and then begin to decline. Depending on net migration, the decline could start as early as 2021 and will almost certainly happen by 2024. Without increases in the percentage of Arizona high school graduates that choose to enroll in higher education, demographic reductions may impact Arizona's long-term educational attainment levels.

Declining enrollment will also impact the universities' financial models. As state support was reduced during the economic downturn, Arizona's public universities have funded a greater percentage of the universities through tuition and by developing entrepreneurial sources of revenue. Arizona's divestment in public higher education has resulted in the board and universities focusing on the number of students enrolled at each institution as well as the mix of resident and non-resident students to ensure the universities remain financially strong for the future.



Twenty-First Day Total Headcount Enrollment and Enterprise Goals



Twenty-First Day Total Headcount Enrollment Growth versus All US Public Bachelor's or Graduate Degree and Certificate Granting Institutions





Exhibit E.ASU.1: Twenty-First Day Total Headcount Enrollment and Enterprise Goals






Exhibit E.ASU.2: Twenty-First Day Total Headcount Enrollment Growth National Comparisons

Twenty-First Day Total Headcount Enrollment Growth versus All US Bachelor's or Graduate Degree and Certificate Granting Institutions




Twenty-First Day Total Headcount Enrollment Growth versus All US Public Bachelor's or Graduate Degree and Certificate Granting Institutions

Forty-Fifth Day Full-Time Equivalent Headcount Enrollment to Twenty-First Day Headcount Enrollment Ratio




Exhibit E.ASU.4: Comparison of Enrollment by Course Level and Residency Status for 21st and 45th Day Reporting Standards








### Exhibit E.ASU.6: Twenty-First Day Total Headcount Enrollment Growth National Comparisons

Twenty-First Day Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment Growth versus All US Bachelor's Degree Granting Institutions




Twenty-First Day Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment Growth versus All US Public Bachelor's Degree Granting Institutions







Twenty-First Day Graduate Headcount Enrollment Growth versus All US Public Graduate Degree and Certificate Granting Institutions




Exhibit E.ASU.9: Twenty-First Day Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment by IPEDS Campus



### Exhibit E.ASU.23: Twenty-First Day Graduate Total Headcount Enrollment by Credit Hours and Arizona Residency




Exhibit E.ASU.24: Twenty-First Day First-Time Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment by IPEDS Home State










### Exhibit E.NAU.2: Twenty-First Day Total Headcount Enrollment Growth National Comparisons

Twenty-First Day Total Headcount Enrollment Growth versus All US Bachelor's or Graduate Degree and Certificate Granting Institutions




Twenty-First Day Total Headcount Enrollment Growth versus All US Public Bachelor's or Graduate Degree and Certificate Granting Institutions

Forty-Fifth Day Full-Time Equivalent Headcount Enrollment to Twenty-First Day Headcount Enrollment Ratio







### Exhibit E.NAU.6: Twenty-First Day Total Headcount Enrollment Growth National Comparisons

Twenty-First Day Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment Growth versus All US Bachelor's Degree Granting Institutions




Twenty-First Day Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment Growth versus All US Public Bachelor's Degree Granting Institutions










### Exhibit E.NAU.8: Twenty-First Day Graduate Headcount Enrollment Growth National Comparisons


Twenty-First Day Graduate Headcount Enrollment Growth versus All US Graduate Degree and Certificate Granting Institutions

### Exhibit E.NAU.9: Twenty-First Day Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment by Credit Hours and IPEDS Campus










Exhibit E.NAU.24: Twenty-First Day First-Time Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment by IPEDS Home State








### Exhibit E.UA.2: Twenty-First Day Total Headcount Enrollment Growth National Comparisons

Twenty-First Day Total Headcount Enrollment Growth versus All US Bachelor's or Graduate Degree and Certificate Granting Institutions




Twenty-First Day Total Headcount Enrollment Growth versus All US Public Bachelor's or Graduate Degree and Certificate Granting Institutions

Forty-Fifth Day Full-Time Equivalent Headcount Enrollment to Twenty-First Day Headcount Enrollment Ratio







Twenty-First Day Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment and Enterprise Goals






### Exhibit E.UA.6: Twenty-First Day Total Headcount Enrollment Growth National Comparisons

Twenty-First Day Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment Growth versus All US Bachelor's Degree Granting Institutions




Twenty-First Day Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment Growth versus All US Public Bachelor's Degree Granting Institutions



Twenty-First Day Graduate Headcount Enrollment Growth versus All US Public Graduate Degree and Certificate Granting Institutions




Exhibit E.UA.9: Twenty-First Day Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment by Credit Hours and IPEDS Campus



Exhibit E.UA.11: Twenty-First Day Graduate Headcount Enrollment by Credit Hours and IPEDS Campus




Exhibit E.UA.12: Twenty-First Day Graduate Headcount Enrollment by Primary Geographic Site






Exhibit E.UA.24: Twenty-First Day First-Time Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment by IPEDS Home State
