
FIRST-TIME STUDENT RETENTION REPORT

FISCAL YEAR 2023



ABOUT THIS REPORT

This report provides retention data for first-time undergraduate students at Arizona's public universities. Retention rates serve as an important leading indicator of progress toward degree completion and a key measure of overall university success. Retention rates are defined as the percentage of first-time students who return to the same institution for a second fall semester.

This report provides retention rate data for each institution, disaggregated by key categories of analysis such as attendance and residency status, academic program, gender and race/ethnicity. Throughout this report, there are exhibits where specific data points have been omitted either because data for prior years was not previously surveyed, or because the data needed to be redacted to maintain student privacy in instances where cross tabulations resulted in five or fewer students.

ABOUT THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

First-time undergraduate student retention is tracked by the board as it is a key indicator of student success and overall university success. Students typically confront the most changes and challenges during their first year; thus, the rate of students returning for their second year is an important metric.

Academic preparation for students entering a university is a primary indicator of future retention. However, academic performance is not the only reason that students don't return to college – they also leave for a range of personal, family and financial reasons.¹

Arizona's public universities employ extensive success programs and support systems to help students address challenges and complete their degrees. There are negative consequences for the individual, university and state of Arizona when a student is unable to continue their education. Student attrition leads to diminished lifetime incomes, higher financial and reputational costs to institutions, and lower returns on state investment.² Student retention is essential to meeting Arizona's educational attainment goals and the development of a 21st-century workforce.

KEY OUTCOMES BY UNIVERSITY

ARIZONA STATE UNIVERSITY

- Full-time, on-campus retention declined slightly year-over-year from 86 percent in 2022 to 85.4 percent in 2023, a 0.6 percentage point decrease. ASU's enterprise metric goal was 89 percent.
- The retention rate for part-time, on-campus students who represented 16.2 percent of first-time students increased from 40.7 percent to 50 percent. ASU's enterprise metric goal was 45 percent.
- ASU full- and part-time online students who represented 15.3 percent of all first-time enrollments – were retained at 50.8 percent in 2023.³

NORTHERN ARIZONA UNIVERSITY

- Full-time, on-campus student retention increased from 75.8 percent in 2022 to 76.1 percent in 2023, a 0.3 percentage point increase.
- Part-time, on-campus student retention, representing 9.5 percent of all first-time enrollments, declined from 46.4 percent to 43.1 percent.
- NAU full- and part-time online students who represented 1.4 percent of all first-time enrollments were retained at 40.3 percent in 2023.

UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA


- Full-time, on-campus student retention increased slightly year-over-year from 84.5 percent to 85.8 percent. The enterprise metric goal was 85.5 percent.
- The retention rate for part-time, on-campus students who represented 27.2 percent of all first-time students – increased from 65 percent to 68.5 percent. UArizona's enterprise metric goal was 66.8 percent.
- UArizona's full- and part-time online students who represented 2.5 percent of all first-time enrollments - decreased from 56.5 percent to 45.5 percent.
- Arizona resident, full-time student retention increased by 0.1, 0.9 and 0.7 percentage points at ASU, NAU and UArizona respectively. Non-resident retention rates changed by -1.5, 2.2 and 2.3 percentage points respectively.
- Pell Grant recipients are retained at lower rates than non-Pell students: 81.7 percent vs. 86.9 percent at ASU; 71.6 percent vs. 78.3 percent at NAU; and 82.1 percent vs. 86.5 percent at UArizona.4
- Online students are retained at lower rates than on-campus students. The online student population can include a relatively high proportion of part-time students, older students and/or students who select the online modality knowing they may stop out of their education.⁵
- The differences in online retention across the three universities reflect a diverse mix of online student characteristics at each institution, such as full-time vs. part-time, and Pell Grant eligibility. Total online first-time students constitute a small proportion of all first-time students – 15.3 percent at ASU, 1.4 percent at NAU and 2.5 percent at UArizona.
- There was, as is to be expected, considerable variance in retention rates across degree programs. At all three institutions, bachelor's degree program retention rates ranged from 100 percent to below 52 percent depending on the program. It is important to note that student election of majors at admission is associated with factors that affect retention, such as high school GPA, Pell Grant eligibility, gender and race/ethnicity.
- Large variances in retention rates across racial and ethnic groups persist at all the universities. It is important to note that there are key factors that interact to influence retention in these student populations, including but not limited to Pell Grant eligibility, part-time vs. full-time attendance, and instructional modality.

⁴Pell Grants are awarded by the federal government to undergraduates with acute financial need. Pell Grant recipient status is routinely employed as a proxy for low-income status.

⁵The board is working with the universities to develop additional persistence metrics and measures to better evaluate online student progress.





Exhibit ASU.FTSR.2: First-Time, Part-Time On-Campus Student Retention Rate and Enterprise Metric Goals




Exhibit ASU.FTSR.3: First-Time Student Retention Rate by Instructional Modality



Exhibit ASU.FTSR.5: First-Time Student Headcount Enrollment by Credit Hours and Program Modality




Exhibit ASU.FTSR.6: Percentage of First-Time Students by Credit Hours and Program Modality




Exhibit ASU.FTSR.7: First-Time Student Retention Rate by Credit Hours and Program Modality




Exhibit ASU.FTSR.8: Average High School GPA of First-Time Students by Credit Hours and Program Modality

Exhibit ASU.FTSR.12: First-Time Student Retention Rate by Credit Hours and Arizona Residency




Exhibit ASU.FTSR.13: First-Time Student Headcount Enrollment by Credit Hours and Pell Status

Exhibit ASU.FTSR.14: First-Time Student Retention Rate by Credit Hours and Pell Status




Exhibit ASU.FTSR.15: First-Time Student Headcount Enrollment by Credit Hours and Age

Exhibit ASU.FTSR.16: First-Time Student Retention Rate by Credit Hours and Age




Exhibit ASU.FTSR.17: First-Time Student Headcount Enrollment by Race Ethnicity and Gender







Exhibit NAU.FTSR.5: First-Time Student Headcount Enrollment by Credit Hours and Program Modality




Exhibit NAU.FTSR.6: Percentage of First-Time Students by Credit Hours and Program Modality





Exhibit NAU.FTSR.7: First-Time Student Retention Rate by Credit Hours and Program Modality

Exhibit NAU.FTSR.12: First-Time Student Retention Rate by Credit Hours and Arizona Residency




Exhibit NAU.FTSR.13: First-Time Student Headcount Enrollment by Credit Hours and Pell Status

Exhibit NAU.FTSR.14: First-Time Student Retention Rate by Credit Hours and Pell Status




Exhibit NAU.FTSR.15: First-Time Student Headcount Enrollment by Credit Hours and Age

Exhibit NAU.FTSR.16: First-Time Student Retention Rate by Credit Hours and Age





Exhibit NAU.FTSR.17: First-Time Student Headcount Enrollment by Race Ethnicity and Gender






Exhibit UA.FTSR.2: First-Time, Part-Time On-Campus Student Retention Rate and Enterprise Metric Goals




Exhibit UA.FTSR.4: First-Time Student Headcount, Retention Rate and Average High School GPA by Geographic Site

Exhibit UA.FTSR.5: First-Time Student Headcount Enrollment by Credit Hours and Program Modality





Exhibit UA.FTSR.6: Percentage of First-Time Students by Credit Hours and Program Modality

Exhibit UA.FTSR.12: First-Time Student Retention Rate by Credit Hours and Arizona Residency




Exhibit UA.FTSR.13: First-Time Student Headcount Enrollment by Credit Hours and Pell Status

Exhibit UA.FTSR.14: First-Time Student Retention Rate by Credit Hours and Pell Status




Exhibit UA.FTSR.15: First-Time Student Headcount Enrollment by Credit Hours and Age

Exhibit UA.FTSR.16: First-Time Student Retention Rate by Credit Hours and Age




Exhibit UA.FTSR.17: First-Time Student Headcount Enrollment by Race Ethnicity and Gender
