ABOUT THIS REPORT

The annual Postsecondary Performance Report examines the performance of the previous year's Arizona high school graduates during their first year at Arizona's public universities. The report details Arizona high school graduates' performance in the aggregate by first-term GPA through the spring semester, enrollment, course level, and grades in English and math courses. The report also presents demographic composition and percentage of students admitted without an academic deficiency.

ABOR Policy 2-121 requires that an Arizona high school graduate successfully complete certain courses for admission into an Arizona public university. For admission purposes, a student's failure to complete these courses prior to enrolling in the university is an academic deficiency. Universities may enroll a student with one academic deficiency in English or mathematics and two deficiencies in the other required courses.

Arizona Revised Statute §15-1822 requires ABOR to produce a Postsecondary Performance Report. In addition to the comprehensive university summaries included in the report, ABOR provides individual reports for each Arizona high school to the Arizona Department of Education.

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

According to the 2022 Postsecondary Performance Report, college retention is high among Arizona high school graduates attending an Arizona public university, with 93 percent of the 2022 graduating class continuing enrollment from the fall to spring semester.

Report data show there is a retention gap among students admitted with all required high school courses compared to those without: 94 percent versus 86 percent respectively. Failure to complete all core courses prior to entering college also results in a lower GPA, with an average 3.2 GPA for those without a course deficiency compared with 2.6 GPA for students admitted with one or more core course deficiency.

Academic preparedness is indicative of student success at Arizona's public universities. Longitudinal data reveals that students who complete the required high school core courses before entering college typically perform better academically and are more likely to persist with their education than those admitted without the full complement of courses.

Of the 16,389 Arizona first-time students admitted to Arizona's public universities in fall 2022, approximately 88 percent completed all the core course requirements prior to enrolling, while 12 percent were admitted with deficiencies in the high school courses that prepare them for college. Twelve percent is similar to past students with core course deficiency admission rates.

Across the universities, 90 percent of Arizona high school graduates passed first-year English with a C grade or higher (in line with 90 percent in fall 2021), while 85 percent of Arizona high school graduates passed college algebra with a C grade or higher (down from 86 percent in fall 2021).
