
FALL ENROLLMENT REPORT

ACADEMIC YEAR 2024



ABOUT THIS REPORT

The Academic Year 2024 Enrollment Report provides enrollment data for students attending Arizona's public universities beginning in the fall of 2023 and updates multi-year enrollment trends. Twenty-first day headcount is provided for each university and their campuses.

Within higher education, enrollment is generally expressed in student headcount or full-time equivalent (FTE) terms. Student headcount is reported to determine educational scale and measurement against the board's strategic metric goals. Headcount is defined as the number of full- or part-time individual students registered at a university for at least one credit hour on the 21st day of instruction. Student headcount is considered a broad measure of a university's educational reach, reflecting the number of individuals the university is educating at one time.

Student enrollment is counted across all education delivery modalities, including online and extended campuses. The report further disaggregates the data into undergraduate, graduate and total enrollment. Data is presented by demographics, full-time and part-time student enrollment semester credit hours and residency status. The report also provides an update on each university's progress toward the metric targets for 21st day resident adult undergraduate enrollment.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Public university enrollment is an integral component of advancing the state's goal to increase educational attainment. It is a key focus for the board and universities as Arizona needs 26,300 more bachelor's degrees annually to support the state's economy.¹

Total enrollment at Arizona's public universities is up, largely due to online enrollment increases

Total student enrollment at Arizona's public universities in fall 2023 was 251,194, a 14.1 percent increase over fall 2022. This is the highest enrollment in Arizona public universities' history. Total enrollment continues to climb primarily due to online programs. In fall 2023, 104,419 students attended an online program at an Arizona public university, reaching 41.6 percent of total enrollment.

The inclusion of University of Arizona Global Campus (UAGC) as part of the University of Arizona drove much of this year's large online enrollment increase, although online enrollment was accelerating prior to the inclusion of UAGC. In the past five years, online enrollment at Arizona's public universities without UAGC increased by 21.4 percent. With the inclusion of UAGC, Arizona's public universities are now the largest public university system provider of online programs in the country.²

In contrast, the state's traditional on-campus undergraduate enrollment at its public universities grew more slowly. There are 121,123 traditional on-campus students enrolled at Arizona State University, Northern Arizona University and the University of Arizona – a 1.7 percent increase from last fall.

University of Arizona Global Campus added thousands of online students

UAGC is a fully online campus that makes undergraduate and graduate degree programs accessible to adult learners. With the addition of UAGC's online programs, UArizona added more than 18,718 undergraduate and 5,634 graduate students to the Arizona public university system. These 24,352 students represent a 32.1 percent growth in the system's online enrollment and 11.1 percent increase in the system's total enrollment from last year.

With the inclusion of UAGC students, nonresident enrollment has now grown to 57.8 percent of Arizona public university students, up from 53 percent in 2022. UAGC has also shifted student demographics, increasing the average student age to 26, up from 25 in fall 2022. System-wide part-time enrollment is now at 26.7 percent, down from 30.7 percent in fall 2022.

Women continue to attend Arizona public universities at higher numbers than men

Women outnumber men at four-year institutions across the county, with women making up 56.9 percent of college enrollment.³ That trend matches enrollment at Arizona's public universities. At ASU, 54.6 percent of undergraduate students are women, a 0.4 percent decrease since last year but up from 53 percent in 2020. NAU's undergraduate students are 63.5 percent female, a 0.3 percentage point increase from fall 2022 and a 2.6 percentage point increase over the last five years. UArizona's undergraduate students are 57.1 percent women. Without UAGC, the undergraduate composition at UArizona is 55.3 percent female.

- Fueled by its online programs, ASU's enrollment continues to increase. ASU is among the largest universities in the nation and its total enrollment continues to increase, seeing historic enrollment growth in fall 2023 fueled by it growing online program. ASU enrolled 145,655 students in fall 2023 114,484 undergraduate students (2.1 percent increase) and 31,171 graduate students (2.4 percent increase). ASU's online enrollment growth has been especially significant increasing by 3,511 students or 5.6 percent in the last year and nearly 50 percent in the last five years. The university now enrolls 66,062 online students, which puts the university on track to soon become a majority online institution, enrolling 45.4 percent of its students in online degree programs. Approximately 82 percent of ASU's online students are nonresident, and three-quarters of those enrolled online are undergraduate students.
- On-campus enrollment decreased from fall 2022 but has grown over the past five years. While ASU's on-campus enrollment decreased in fall 2023 by 318 undergraduate students (0.5 percent) and 154 graduate students (1.1 percent), net growth increased by 1,858 students since fall 2019. New on-campus students declined in fall 2023, with 1,588 fewer first-time and transfer students enrolled at ASU. Fewer Arizona residents also choose to attend ASU on-campus this year, decreasing by 472 students (0.6 percent). Over the last five years, Arizona resident enrollment decreased by 2.3 percent, while nonresident enrollment increased by 14.5 percent.
- More nonresident undergraduate students enroll at ASU. The total number of oncampus and online nonresident undergraduates increased to 63,221 in fall 2023, or 3.9 percent. Together, these nonresident undergraduates now represent over 55 percent of all undergraduate students at ASU.
- ASU continues to enroll more historically underrepresented undergraduate students. ASU's charter states that the university will be measured not by whom it excludes, but by whom it includes and how they succeed. In fall 2023, 33.6 percent of ASU's undergraduate students qualified for Pell grants, a 2.6-point increase from last year. Additionally, 32 percent of ASU undergraduate students are from historically underrepresented student populations Black, Hispanic or Native American a 2.4 percent enrollment increase from fall 2022 and a 24 percent increase over the last five years.

Northern Arizona University

 NAU's enrollment remained steady from last fall. NAU's total enrollment remained steady year-over-year with 28,186 students — 23,128 undergraduate students, a slight loss of 76 students. In the past five years, NAU's undergraduate enrollment lost 12.8 percent, but appears to have leveled out in the past two years. The university increased its graduate enrollment by 176 students for a total of 5,058 graduate students, an increase of 3.6 percent.

- NAU enrolls predominantly resident students. This year, NAU launched its Access2Excellence (A2E) tuition program. A2E ensures full tuition coverage for Arizona resident students whose family annual income is \$65,000 or below or who are members of Arizona's 22 federally recognized Native American tribes. NAU saw a notable 3.2 percent increase in Arizona resident undergraduate students from last fall, totaling 16,256 residents in fall 2023. Arizona residents now comprise 70.3 percent of NAU's undergraduate students. Of the 6,872 nonresident students enrolled, 58.7 percent are part of the Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) program, and another 6.4 percent are international students.
- **First-time and transfer students decreased at NAU this fall.** Since fall 2022, the number of first-time and transfer students at NAU decreased by 2.1 percent. NAU is currently implementing its Arizona Attainment Alliance (A++) program with Arizona's community colleges to help increase the number of transfer students.
- The majority of NAU's undergraduate enrollment is on its Flagstaff campus. More than 82 percent of NAU's undergraduate students attend its Flagstaff campus, while 6.6 percent (2,353) attend one of NAU's statewide locations. Of those, NAU Yuma has the largest undergraduate enrollment with 394 undergraduate students enrolled. NAU's undergraduate online enrollment decreased by 258 students (8.9 percent), with 11.4 percent (2,645) of NAU's total undergraduates enrolled online.
- Undergraduates from historically underrepresented groups continues to increase. As part of its new charter, NAU aims to be the nation's preeminent engine of opportunity, vehicle of economic mobility, and driver of social impact by delivering equitable postsecondary value in Arizona and beyond. NAU's on-campus Pell student enrollment increased by 193 students or 3.4 percent since last fall, demonstrating the power of its Access2Excellence financial aid program. Online Pell student enrollment at NAU declined by 6.3 percent to 926. Approximately 33 percent of NAU's undergraduates are from historically underrepresented student populations Black, Hispanic or Native American. This is a 2.2 percent enrollment increase from fall 2022.

University of Arizona


- UArizona enrollment increased by more than half. Fall 2023 enrollment at UArizona is the largest and most diverse in its history with 77,353 students, a 56.6 percent increase. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 56.4 percent and graduate enrollment increased by 57.1 percent. These substantial enrollment increases include strong on-campus enrollment growth but are largely due to the inclusion of UAGC online students.
- **UAGC increases online enrollment and changes UArizona's student population mix.** With the inclusion of UAGC students this fall, UArizona now enrolls 43.5 percent of its students online. These 33,616 online students are a 304.5 percent increase from the number of online students enrolled in fall 2022. The average age of UArizona students

increased in fall 2023 from 23.5 to 27.5. Without including UAGC, the average age of enrollment would have been unchanged.

- On-campus enrollment is up in fall 2023. UArizona also increased its undergraduate on-campus students by 2,194 or 6.6 percent from fall 2022. This on-campus enrollment growth includes both increases of resident and nonresident students. On-campus graduate enrollment also increased by 5.8 percent from last fall.
- UArizona substantially increased the number of historically underrepresented students enrolled. Approximately 36.5 percent of UArizona students are from historically underrepresented populations — Black, Hispanic or Native American a 79.5 percent increase from fall 2022 and a 106.5 percent increase over fall 2019. Compared with last year, the inclusion of UAGC alone increased UArizona's Black student enrollment by 335.4 percent and Hispanic student enrollment 40.2 percent. Without the inclusion of UAGC students, UArizona saw a 6.6 percent increase in the number of Black, Hispanic and Native American students enrolled. A year after announcing its Arizona Native Scholars Grant, the number of American Indian or Alaska Native undergraduate students jumped over 53 percent to 761.
- More Pell students enrolled at UArizona. In fall 2023, UArizona increased its Pell student enrollment by 40.6 percent. This was largely due to UAGC. Without the inclusion of UAGC, UArizona still saw a notable increase in Pell students enrolled, at 7.8 percent over fall 2022.




Exhibit ASU.FE.2: Twenty-First Day Resident Adult Undergraduate Headcount and Enterprise Metric Targets





Exhibit ASU.FE.3: Twenty-First Day Graduate Headcount and Enterprise Goals

Cumulative Percentage Change versus All US Public Graduate Degree Granting Institutions




Exhibit ASU.FE.4: Twenty-First Day Undergraduate Headcount by Instructional Modality and Credit Hours




Exhibit ASU.FE.5: Twenty-First Day Undergraduate Headcount by Geographic Site and Credit Hours

Exhibit ASU.FE.6: Twenty-First Day Graduate Headcount by Instructional Modality and Credit Hours




Exhibit ASU.FE.7: Twenty-First Day Graduate Headcount by Geographic Site and Credit Hours




Exhibit ASU.FE.9: Twenty-First Day Headcount by Program Level, Student Year, Credit Hours and Modality





Cumulative Percentage Change versus All US Public Bachelor's Degree Granting Institutions





Exhibit NAU.FE.2: Twenty-First Day Resident Adult Undergraduate Headcount and Enterprise Metric Targets

Cumulative Percentage Change versus All US Public Graduate Degree Granting Institutions




Exhibit NAU.FE.4: Twenty-First Day Undergraduate Headcount by Instructional Modality and Credit Hours




Exhibit NAU.FE.5: Twenty-First Day Undergraduate Headcount by Geographic Site and Credit Hours

Exhibit NAU.FE.6: Twenty-First Day Graduate Headcount by Instructional Modality and Credit Hours




Exhibit NAU.FE.7: Twenty-First Day Graduate Headcount by Geographic Site and Credit Hours

Exhibit NAU.FE.17: Twenty-First Day Undergraduate Headcount by Arizona Residency and Credit Hours





Exhibit NAU.FE.18: Twenty-First Day Graduate Headcount by Arizona Residency and Credit Hours






Exhibit UA.FE.2: Twenty-First Day Resident Adult Undergraduate Headcount and Enterprise Metric Targets





Exhibit UA.FE.3: Twenty-First Day Graduate Headcount and Enterprise Goals

Exhibit UA.FE.4: Twenty-First Day Undergraduate Headcount by Instructional Modality and Credit Hours




Exhibit UA.FE.5: Twenty-First Day Undergraduate Headcount by Geographic Site and Credit Hours

Exhibit UA.FE.6: Twenty-First Day Graduate Headcount by Instructional Modality and Credit Hours




Exhibit UA.FE.7: Twenty-First Day Graduate Headcount by Geographic Site and Credit Hours






